World Pandemic Monitor Subscription Terms and Conditions

- 1) **AGREEMENT** - The World Pandemic Monitor ("Service") will be provided to Subscriber as offered by iJET International, Inc. (iJET) in the World Pandemic Monitor Service Order Form. These terms contain the entire Agreement between the Subscriber and iJET for the use of the Service. This Agreement may be revised by iJET at any time upon written notice, and Subscriber agrees that Subscriber shall be bound by the terms of such revised agreement subject to termination rights under Sections 2 and 6 below.
- 2) **PAYMENT** – Subscriber agrees to pay iJET for the use of the Service at the then-current published rate and fees of iJET. iJET reserves the right to change its rate and fees, but Subscriber may terminate the Agreement as of the effective date of such changes by notifying iJET prior to termination of the Agreement. All invoices from iJET are payable in US dollars and due and **payable upon receipt**. iJET reserves the right to impose a **late fee charge** of 1.5% per month for invoices remaining unpaid more than 30 days past due. Subscriber shall be responsible for paying all sales and use taxes related to the Service provided hereunder.
- 3) **RIGHTS OF INFORMATION** – All information offered in the Service is provided directly by iJET and is copyrighted material. Subscriber understands and agrees that iJET is the exclusive owner, and holds and shall retain, all right, title, and interest in and to the information provided in the Service. Subscriber shall not reverse engineer, disassemble, decompile or otherwise attempt to derive source code relating to the Service or to create any derivative works relating to the Service. This Agreement shall give the Subscriber a non-exclusive and non-transferable license for the term to use the Service. Subscriber agrees that, except for internal use or unless specific permission is granted in writing, Subscriber will not publish, broadcast, retransmit or resell such information or in any way violate the copyright of iJET. This provision is for the benefit of iJET and other information providers and each shall have the right to enforce its right hereunder and on its own behalf. Subscriber agrees to indemnify, defend and hold iJET harmless from any claim, for infringement of copyright, or for any other proprietary right, or due to fraud, misrepresentation, or unlawful acts by Subscriber with regard to the information provided in the Service.

IN NO EVENT SHALL iJET BE LIABLE FOR ANY DIRECT, INDIRECT, SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES CAUSED BY ANY FAILURE OF PERFORMANCE, MISTAKES, OMISSIONS, INTERRUPTIONS, DELETION OF FILES, DEFECTS, DELAYS IN OPERATION OR TRANSMISSION, COMMUNICATIONS LINES FAILURES, THEFT, DESTRUCTION, UNAUTHORIZED ACCESS TO OR USE OF SUBSCRIBER'S SERVICE RECORDS, FILES OR PROGRAMS, OR FOR ANY FAILURE OR INABILITY TO PERFORM BY iJET AND ITS SUBCONTRACTORS. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL iJET BE LIABLE FOR ACTUAL COMPENSATORY DAMAGES FOR ANY CLAIM ARISING OUT OF THE AGREEMENT IN AN AMOUNT IN EXCESS OF ONE HALF OF THE AMOUNT PAID BY SUBSCRIBER TO iJET FOR A ONE YEAR SUBSCRIPTION.

Neither iJET nor any of its subcontractors shall be liable to Subscriber for any cost, expense, or damages whatsoever for terminating the Agreement as provided in Section 7 hereof.

MISCELLANEOUS – This Agreement is subject to acceptance by iJET and may not be assigned by Subscriber and shall be governed by the laws of the State of Maryland. If this Agreement is breached by Subscriber, then Subscriber shall be responsible for all expenses, losses and attorneys fees incurred due to Subscriber's default, including any cost relating to injunctive relief.
